

DRURY SCHOOL: Policy 5.05 Drug Free (and Managing Drug Related Incidents)

Rationale:

Drury Primary School promotes and endorses a drug-free environment. This excludes the use of legally prescribed medications.

Purposes:

- To provide a Drug Free environment for all.
- To promote an environment consistent with current health care programmes where students are educated about drugs and drug issues.
- To provide positive role models for students.
- Discourage all unnecessary drug uses that may be detrimental to the health and well-being of students and staff.

Guidelines:

1. **Tobacco:** Under the Smoke Free Environmental Act 2004 smoking in any form is prohibited within school buildings or school grounds.
2. **Alcohol:** No students are permitted to possess or consume alcohol whilst on the school premises. Staff are not permitted to consume alcohol during school hours. If alcohol is to be served on the school premises at a school function, approval must be gained from the Principal and/or the Board of Trustees.
3. **Inhalants:** No persons are permitted to inhale or otherwise ingest a solvent or other industrial products whilst on school premises or at school functions.
4. **Illicit Drugs:** The school prohibits the possession, consumption or supply of any illicit drug by any person on the school premises or at any school related events.
5. **Paraphernalia:** The school prohibits the possession of any drug paraphernalia by any person on the school premises or at any school related events.
